\$1 million secured in state funding for Florida's five ALS Certified Centers of Excellence



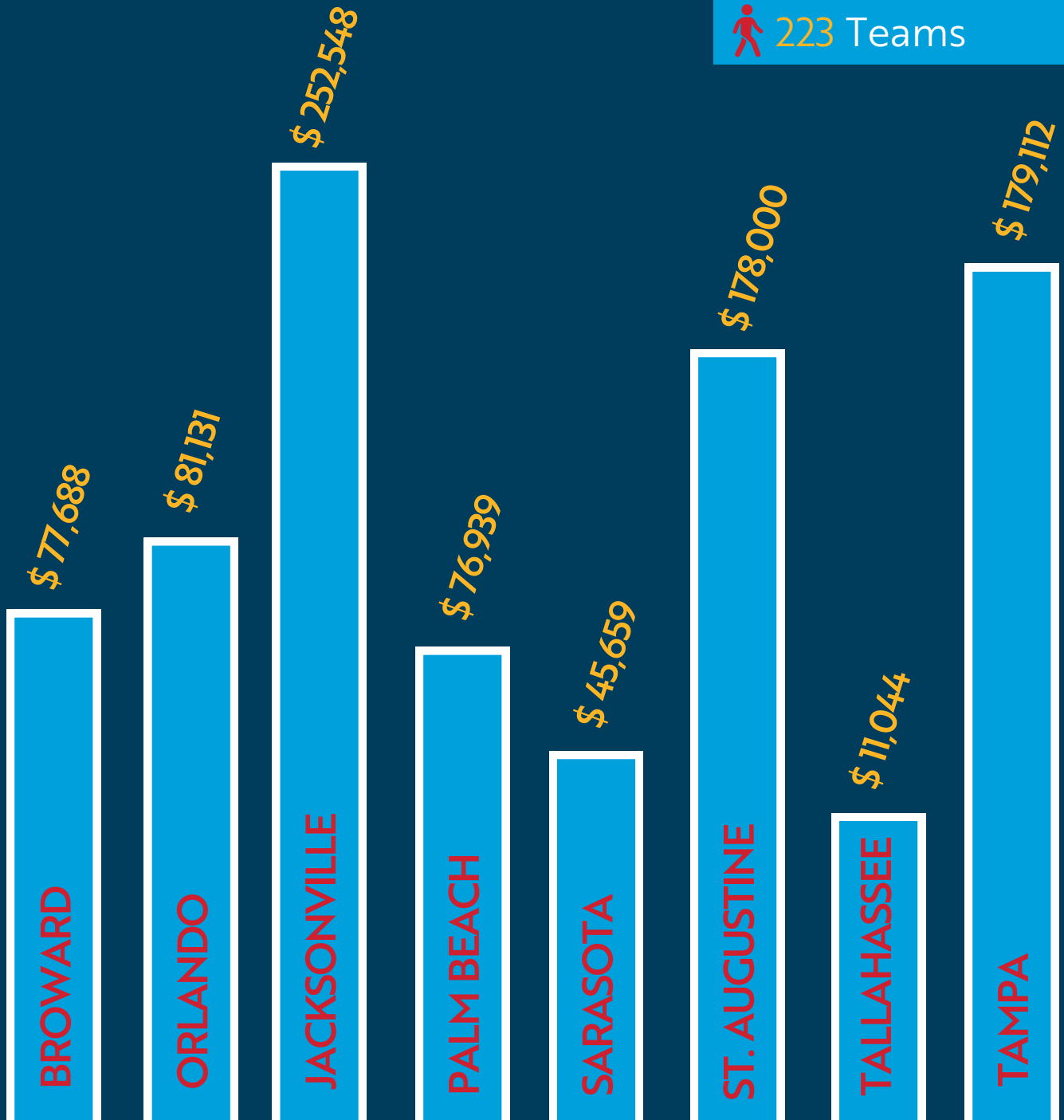
